Introduction

Are you likely to have future support with adult social care? Do you feel it is opaque and hard to navigate, and would you appreciate the information and skills to help you to navigate through this change of support?

Every year, thousands of young people transition from children's social care to adults' social care. This workshop is designed to support young people, their families and carers in transitioning from children's social care to adults' social care with the information, advice and guidance they need.

Who is this workshop for?

This workshop is suitable for any young people, their families and carers, where there is an assessed likelihood of support continuing from children's social care into adults' social care.

What will the workshop involve?

The workshop will be held online and will be delivered by a SCIE subject expert. To join the workshop you will need access to a computer, tablet, or phone, and an internet connection.

By attending the workshop you will gain a realistic understanding of adults' social care and will learn about:

- Likely pathways into adult social care
- Legislation overviews of children's social care and adults' social care
- Regulations overviews of children's social care and adults' social care
- National and local set up
- Practice frameworks differences and similarities
- Personalisation, strengths-based approaches and co-production
- Self-advocacy approaches and developing a toolkit
- Developing a personalised self-advocacy plan.

How long is the workshop?

The workshop lasts for half a day.
