

Lower School Spring Term Topic Morning

This term, we have thoroughly enjoyed exploring our topic, "Who Are Your Heroes?" To celebrate our learning and provide pupils with hands-on experiences, we hosted a themed morning filled with exciting opportunities to interact, explore, and discover. Pupils rotated around four engaging stations.

Hero Sound Buttons - at this station, pupils explored the sounds made by everyday heroes in our community. Using a range of switches, they experienced clear cause-and-effect responses. Sirens and rescue-dog barks were particular favourites, sparking lots of curiosity.

Hero Feely Boxes - a hands-on sensory exploration station, invited pupils to reach into sensory "feely boxes" containing objects linked to doctors and nurses, firefighters, rescue workers, and vets. This tactile experience opened the door to imaginative play.

Make Your Own Hero Medal - our creative station, pupils designed and crafted their very own hero medals. This activity celebrated their creativity and reinforced our message that they are heroes too. Pupils highly enjoyed creating their medals and wore them with pride.

Who Helps Me? - a matching station where pupils explored items used by helpers in our community and matched each object to the professional who would use it. This encouraged problem-solving and deepened their understanding of the important roles these heroes play in everyday life.
